## A) WAIT EDUCATION PROGRAMS

WAIT is a registered trademark for the SCWF environmental program that encourages the protection and enhancement of wildlife habitat on industry lands. To become certified, an applicant must have a systematic program for its site that includes: 1) environmental education of employees and community partners regarding wildlife and its habitat, and 2) wildlife habitat enhancements.

Examples: Plant and animal identification books, educational posters, wildlife seminars, site bird and/or plant lists, etc., in breakroom or library; wildlife viewing area; educational signs on site, etc.
